



Ordinal values of the English language would be to give a value of one to the letter A, two to the letter B, 32 the letter C, and so on until you get to giving the letter Z the value of 26.

As we know seven is God's number universally accepted (Seven days of the week, ...) The odds that this happened, coincidentally or accidentally is beyond astronomical.









The ancient Hebrew alphabet has 22 letters (from Alef to Tav). The earliest characters originally consisted of symbols (first column), from which the today's digital signs originated. Five of them have special end forms (e.g., Kaph). The letters Alef (1) and Ayin (16) have a sound that does not occur in our language, so their pronunciation is in brackets. Although the Syriac (Syr; Aramaic) language is similar, it has produced completely new letters over the centuries (see Peshitta).

The ancient Greek alphabet has 27 letters. In addition to the 24 main letters (from Alpha to Omega) in which the NT was written, there were 3 more characters in the early form of the Greek alphabet; i.e. in the alphabetic ("Milesian") system of Greek numerals: Digamma" (F, r; [w]; since the Middle Ages Stigma in the appearance of a snake: C, c; NV 6), Qoppa (NV 90) and Sampi (NV 900). Both alphabets have together 22+27=49 (7x7) letters. The whole Bible (OT and NT) was written on 22+27=49 (7x7) scrolls. <u>Abbreviations</u>: (OV): Ordinal value, the order of the letters in the alphabet. (NV): numerical value (Gematria = Interpretation of words by numbers). (P): Pronunciation or Transcription. The letters may look different in some sources because they are often shown in multiple fonts, e.g. Arial (ARL) or Times New Roman (TNR). In Greek, there are uppercase or lowercase letters.
